18 ROSH HODESH New Month/New Moon celebrated on the first day of each lunar month. The moon gives us God's designation of a month, with each month beginning with the appearance of the New Moon and being approximately 29 1/2 days in length. The New Moon is to be celebrated on the first day of the month, and was in Biblical times, a time for rejoicing, worship, blowing the shofars, peace offerings and burnt sacrifices. שבת BIBLICAL SABBATH, day of holiness and rest observed by Jews from sunset on Friday to nightfall of the following day. The time division follows the biblical story of creation: "And there was evening and there was morning, one day" (Genesis 1:5). **Weekly observance** begins with candle lighting Friday evening before sunset & ends Saturday at nightfall. In Jewish homes the woman of the house lights white Sabbath candles before sunset on Friday evening and pronounces a benediction. The Sabbath meal that follows is preceded by the Kiddush (blessing of sanctification). **SHABBAT SHALOM** *Blessed are you ADONAI our God, King of the Universe who sanctified us by your Word, & commanded us to be a light for the nations & gave us YESHUA /Jesus our Messiah, the light of the world.*
