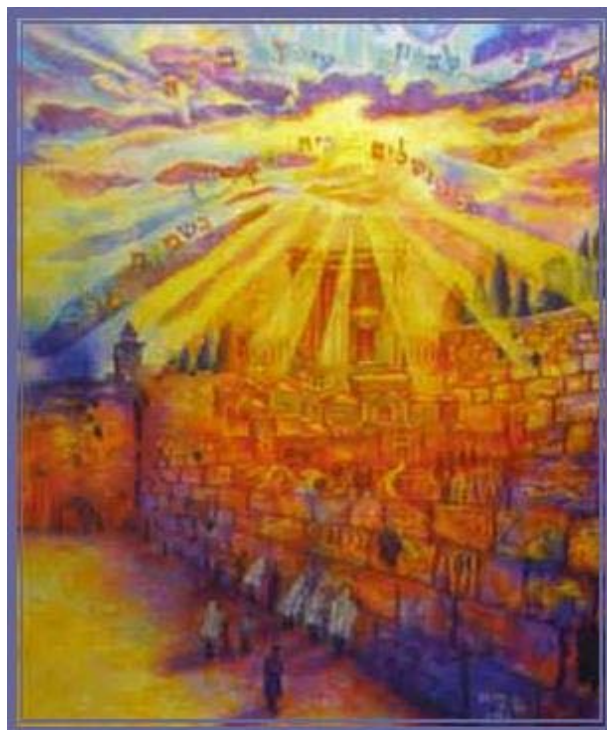

**PRAY FOR SHALOM IN JERUSALEM**

Tehillah-Psalm 122:6 **שְׁאֲלוּ שְׁלוֹם יְרוּשָׁלַם יִשְׁרָאֵל אֲהַבְיָהּ**

*Pray for shalom in Yerushalayim; may those who love you prosper.*

- **JESUS/YESHUA יְשׁוּעָה** means salvation, the peace/shalom Jerusalem needs! -

**שבת BIBLICAL SABBATH**, day of holiness and rest observed by Jews from sunset on Friday to nightfall of the following day. The time division follows the biblical story of creation: "And there was evening and there was morning, one day" (Genesis 1:5). **Weekly observance** begins with candle lighting Friday evening before sunset & ends Saturday at nightfall. In Jewish homes the woman of the house lights white Sabbath candles before sunset on Friday evening and pronounces a benediction. The Sabbath meal that follows is preceded by the Kiddush (blessing of sanctification). **SHABBAT SHALOM** Blessed are you **ADONAI** our God, King of the Universe who sanctified us by your Word, & commanded us to be a light for the nations & gave us **YESHUA** /Jesus our Messiah, the light of the world.
